SERVICE	DESCRIPTION
● Adoptive Parent & Relative Caregiver Respite & Family Support Events	Fun Events for families with adopted children or families caring for relative children. Call for dates and times.
● Domestic Violence Counseling	Therapy that focuses on domestic violence issues for but not limited to: problem solving skills, emotional support, taking control over life situations, enhanced self-esteem.
● Domestic Violence Legal Assistance	Legal Assistance for domestic violence victims such as: restraining orders, custody, dissolutions/divorce, legal counseling.
● English as a Second Language (ESL)	English class for adults 18yrs old and older, beginner level. Classes are held Mondays, Tuesdays, & Wednesdays 6:00pm-9:00pm. Childcare provided.
● Family Advocacy	Case Management to assist and link families to agencies in the community, according to their specific needs.
● Folkloric Dance Group	Traditional Mexican dance class for children ages 5-12. Classes are held Thursday afternoons
● Guitar Classes	Acoustic guitar lessons for 9-12 years old. Call for dates and times.
● Healthy Families/Medi-Cal/Medicare Application Assistance	Assistance in applying for Healthy Families, Medi-Cal or Medicare from a certified representative. The representative is available on Wednesday's 10am-12pm.
● Individual and Family Counseling	Therapy for but not limited to: independent living skills, self-control, cycle of abuse and victimization, and modifying. Dysfunctional behaviors. Please call for an appointment.
● Information and Referral	Assistance in locating resources such as health care, child care, legal aid, housing ,educational classes, food and emergency needs
● Parenting Education Classes	Series of classes for parents on topics such as: logical consequences, modeling appropriate behavior, self control during stressful situations, communication skills.
● Parent Education Workshops	Two hour classes on parenting. Topics include but not limited to: modeling appropriate behaviors, limit set and boundaries, child development, teaching self control, communicating with adolescents.
● Parent Lending Library	Parent and children's books in English and Spanish available for checkout, Open Daily.
● Sewing Class	A weekly course for adults that teaches how to sew, take body measurements and much more. Classes are held on Thursday's from 4:00pm-6:00pm. Childcare provided
● Tutoring	Tutoring for children in grades K-6 th . Tutoring is available Monday-Thursday 3pm-4:30pm
